After receiving an honorable discharge, Lanzinger has worked for the Ohio Attorney General's Office as an assistant attorney general. “Veterans such as Josh Lanzinger have a tremendous amount to offer in terms of virtuous leadership, integrity, professionalism, and service,” said Prestanski. “Our mission is to educate citizens on the need to maintain a strong national defense and to help elect qualified veterans and like-minded non-veterans to office. We are strong advocates of legislation that fully supports our troops, military families and Veterans and we work to ensure that every military absentee ballot is counted in every election.
