ARMY VETERAN DR. BRAD WENSTRUP RECEIVES OHIO VETERANS UNITED ENDORSEMENT FOR US CONGRESS

CINCINNATI – February 2, 2012 – Ohio Veterans United today announced the endorsement of Dr. Brad Wenstrup for US Congress in the Ohio 2nd Congressional District. The announcement was made by Harry Prestanski, executive director and founding member of Ohio Veterans United. “Ohio Veterans United is very proud to endorse our fellow veteran, Brad Wenstrup,” said Prestanski. “Following a thorough review of the candidates’ backgrounds, experiences, and positions on issues, we believe that Dr. Wenstrup shares our core values, including being a staunch and effective supporter of veterans,” says Prestanski. “He has shown a dedication to service and commitment to state and community.”

In Feb. 1998, Dr. Wenstrup accepted a commission with the U.S. Army Reserve and later served with the 344th Combat Support Hospital in Iraq as the Podiatrist and the Chief of Surgery as well as the Director of the Wound Care Clinic. Major Wenstrup was also the assistant to the Deputy Commander of Clinical Services. For his service and actions in Iraq, Wenstrup was awarded the Bronze Star and Combat Action Badge. He has continued his service in the U.S. Army Reserve as a Lieutenant Colonel.

Wenstrup has also been actively involved in community programs and organizations. He volunteered for 14 years as part of the Big Brothers/ Big Sisters organization and he is currently a board member of Boys Hope/ Girls Hope, member of the Cincinnati Rotary, and is the founder and president of Thank America First Foundation.

“Veterans such as Brad Wenstrup have a tremendous amount to offer in terms of virtuous leadership, integrity, professionalism, and service,” said Prestanski. “Our mission is to educate
